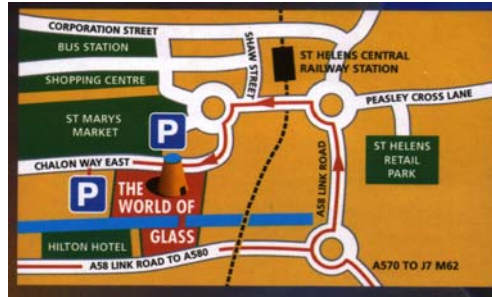




Linda, Neil and Ron paddling in the North Sea at Dunstanburgh
